UNIT 1

We greet people differently around the world. People wave. People bow. People shake hands. People kiss. People hug. Some people have a special greeting. And we all have different ways to say hello.

In English-speaking countries, there are many different ways to say 'Hi. How are you?' to friends and family.

In the United States, friends say 'Hey!' and 'What's up?'.

In Australia, friends say 'G'day!' or 'How's it going?'.

In the United Kingdom, friends say 'Hiya!' and 'Alright?'.

'What's up?', 'How's it going?', and 'Alright?' are not really questions. They're ways to say hello.

We usually reply, 'I'm fine. How are you?'

UNIT 2

Tokyo, Dubai, and Bogotá – three cities where old meets new. Let's go and see them.

First, welcome to Tokyo – the capital city of Japan. In *Marunouchi*, people work in tall new offices. They come and go from Tokyo Station. Tokyo station is old and beautiful. This is *Shinjuku*. In Bangkok in Thailand, there are commuter boats. The boats travel on the city's canals and rivers. Bangkok's roads are very busy. But these boats are a fast way to travel.

This is La Paz in Bolivia. Here, the cable cars carry commuters down the mountain to work. The cable cars can carry 18,000 people every hour. There are 39 stations. The tickets are very cheap – just three bolivianos, or 33 pence. It's a beautiful way to get to work.

UNIT 7

What is a flea market? At a flea market, people buy and sell old things. Every object is different. Flea markets have a long history.

This Paris flea market is 200 years old. The market is called 'Les Puces.' Les Puces means 'the fleas.' Fleas are small insects. In the past, some of the things in the market had fleas. The English word 'flea market' comes from the name of this market.

The *Ecants* flea market in Barcelona is 500 years old. It now has a beautiful new building. They sell clothes, chairs and all kinds of things.

Every flea market is different. At *Izmailovsky* Market in Russia, you can buy a fur hat or a Russian doll and have a kebab when you're hungry.

The Grand Bazaar in Turkey is very famous. It's 550 years old. You can buy many things here: Spices. Gold. Scarves. Lanterns. Many tourists come here. They take photos of the beautiful old buildings. And buy presents for family and friends. You can spend a long time at a flea market! And a lot of money.

UNIT 11

James: It's an incredible feeling ... It took James 175 days to go around the world by gyrocopter. How is he going to travel next time?
