In English, we do not use the double negative. We use **never** with the affirmative form of the verb.

My dad **never** watches TV.

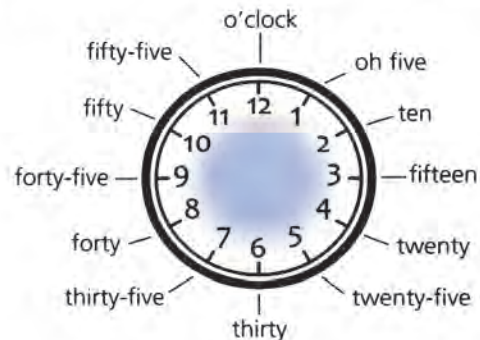
NOT My dad ~~doesn't~~ never watch TV.

## Prepositions of time

- We use *on* with days of the week, dates, and the word *weekend*.**  
*on* Monday(s)  
*on* July 12<sup>th</sup>  
*on* the weekend / *on* weekends
- We use *at* with times and with the word *night*.**  
*at* four o'clock  
*at* 8.30 p.m.  
*at* night
- We use *in* for parts of the day, months, and years.**  
*in* the morning  
*in* March  
*in* 2011

## The time

- In English, we rarely use the 24 hour clock to tell the time. We divide the 24 hours into two periods of twelve hours.**
  - We use a.m. (*ante meridiem*) to show the twelve hours before twelve o'clock noon.**  
 8 a.m. 10:45 a.m.
  - We use p.m. (*post meridiem*) to show the twelve hours before twelve o'clock midnight.**  
 8 p.m. 10:45 p.m.
- We also use the following expressions to tell the time.**  
 (two) o'clock  
 (two) oh five, ten, fifteen, twenty, thirty, thirty-five, forty, forty-five, fifty, fifty-five



- We use the expressions *in the morning*, *in the afternoon*, *in the evening*, and *at night* to tell the time at different times of the day.**  
 3 a.m. = It's three o'clock **in the morning**.  
 3 p.m. = It's three o'clock **in the afternoon**.  
 8 p.m. = It's eight o'clock **in the evening**.  
 12 p.m. = It's twelve o'clock **at night**.

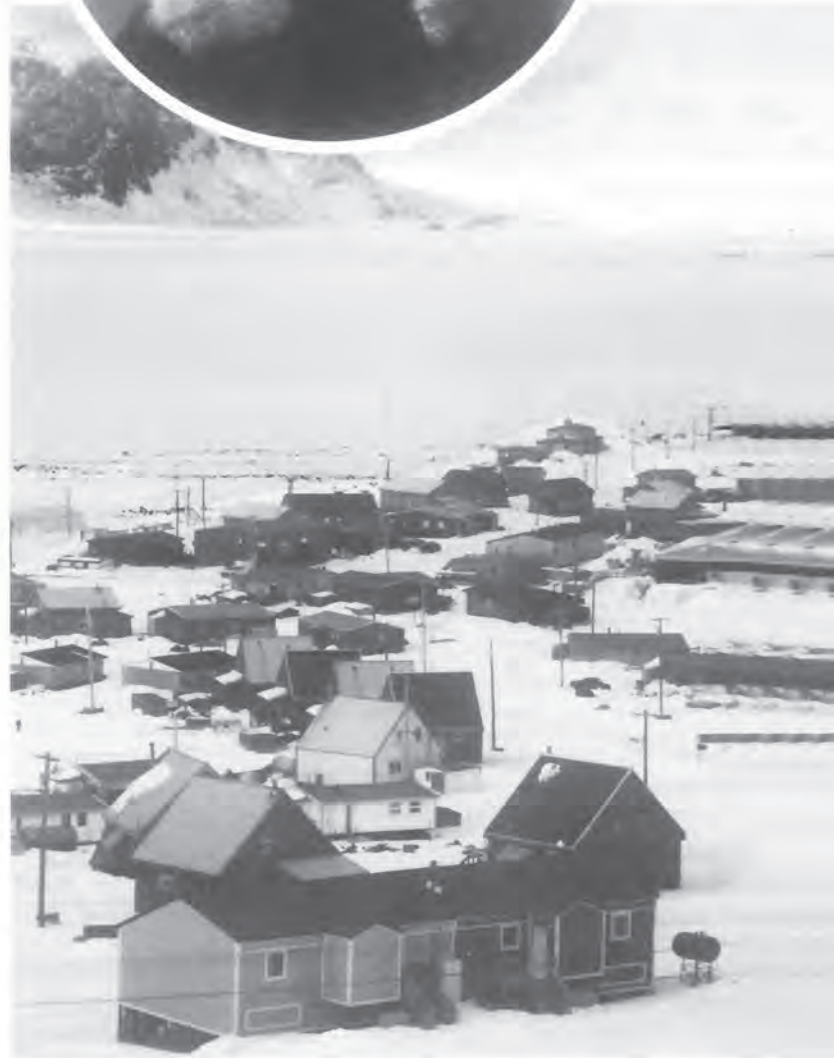

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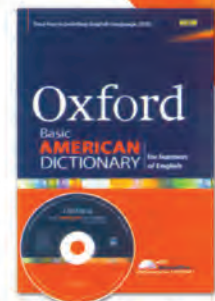


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
