"Me, too!" says Todd.

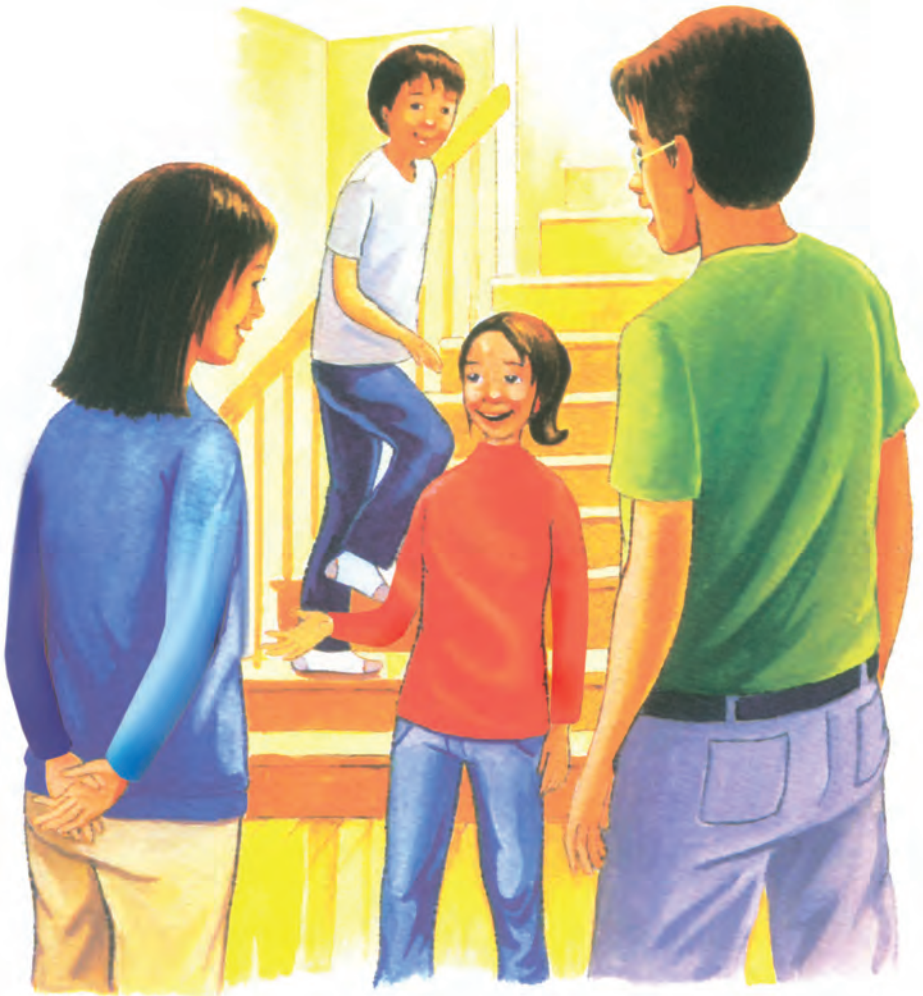


Penny asks, "Should we take our swimsuits and sunscreen?"
