"Let me look," said April.

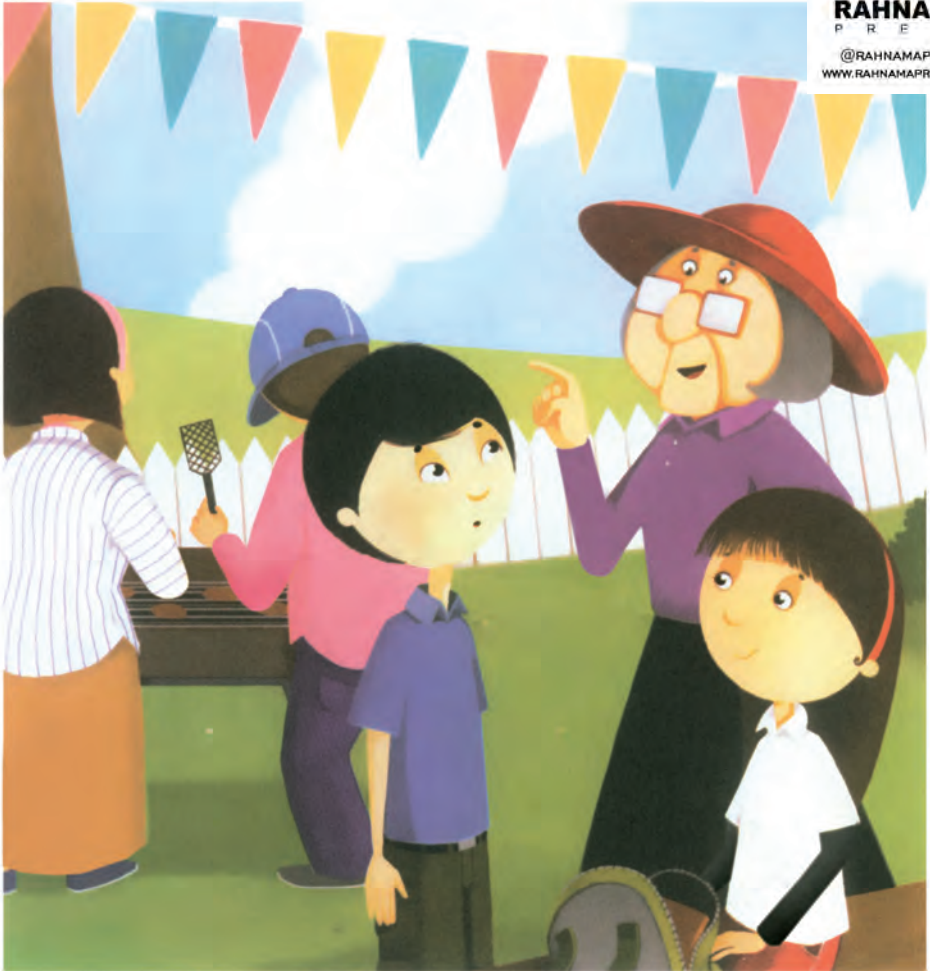
"It's red, and it has **stickers** on it," said Matt.
