Danny's Sick Day

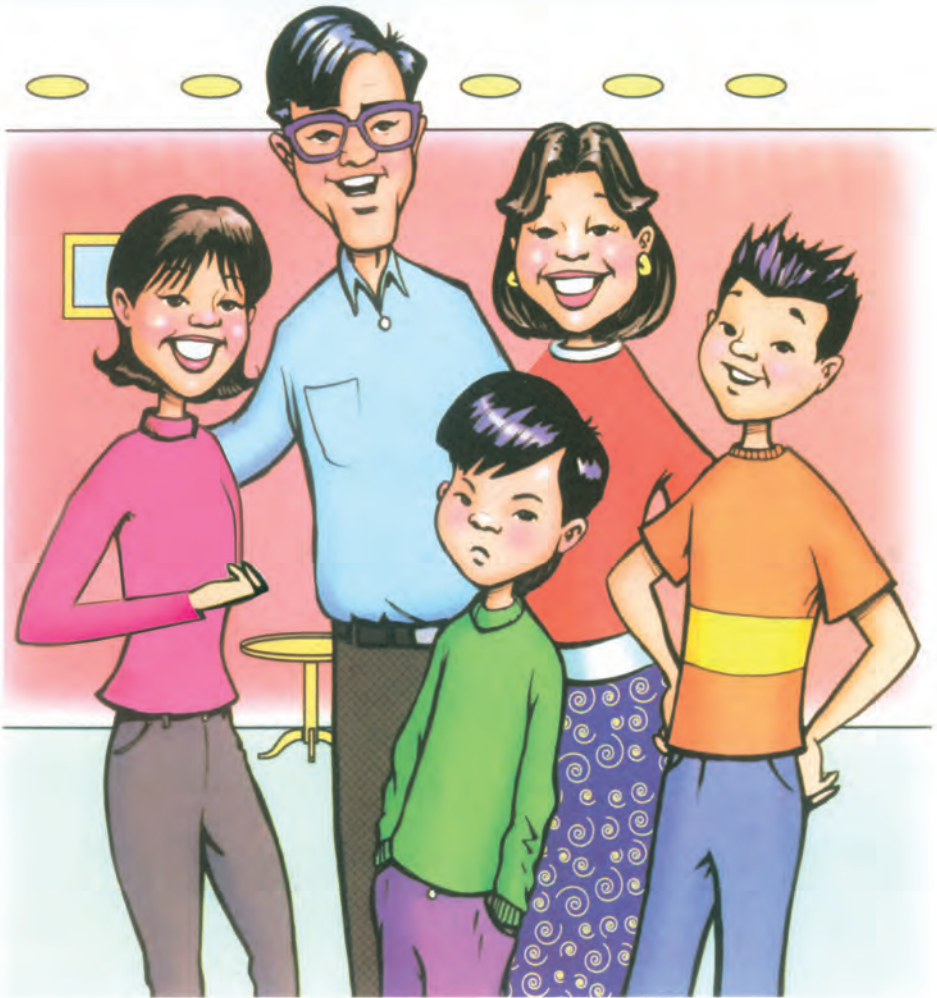
