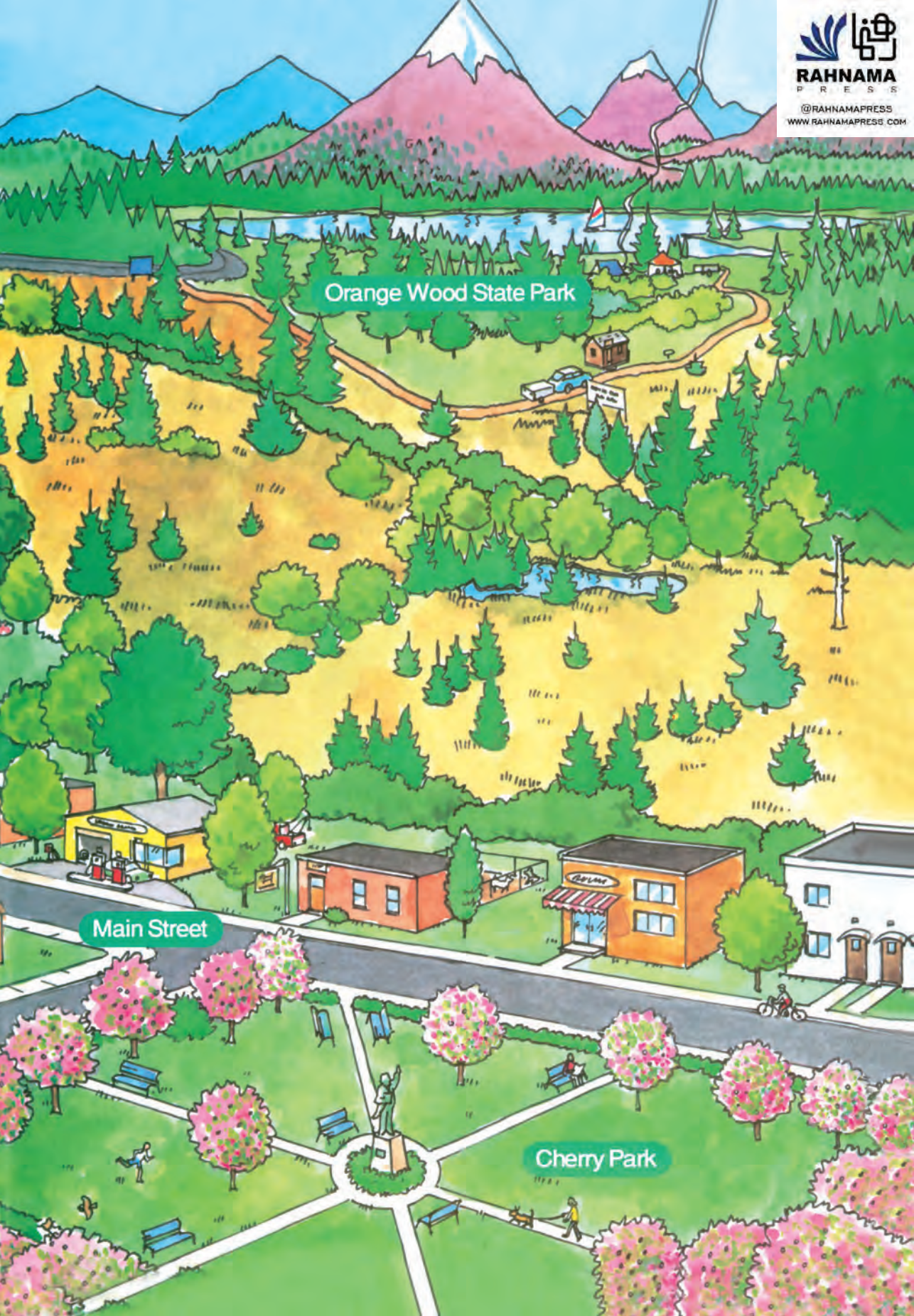

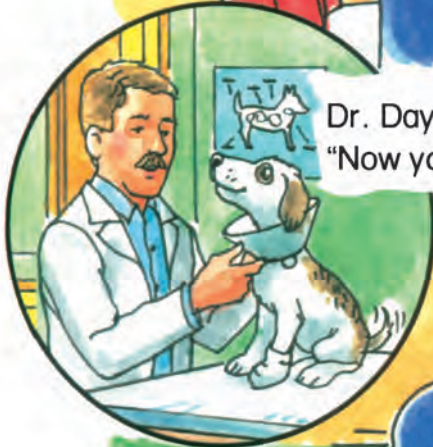

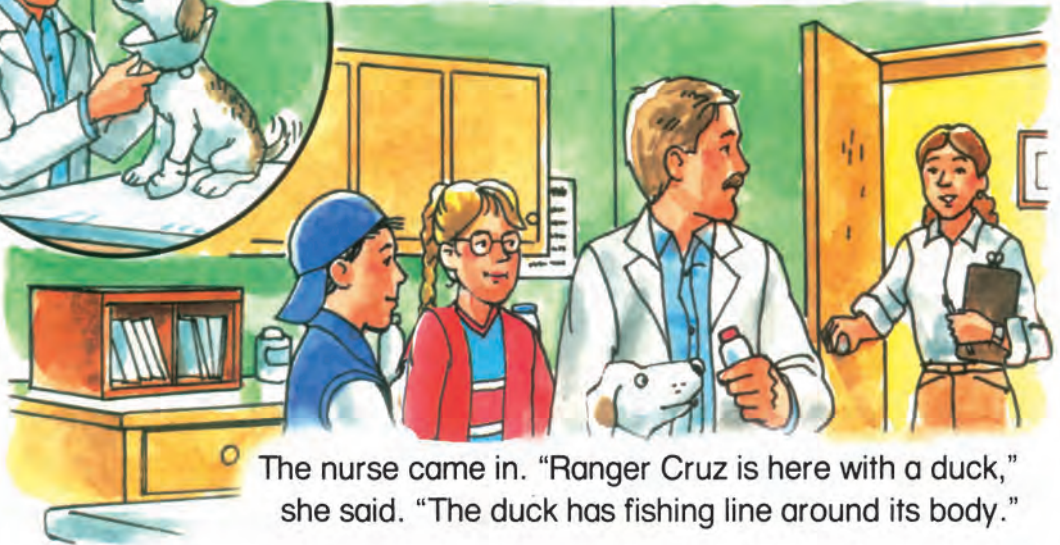
At the clinic, Dr. Day pulled a piece of glass out of Digger's paw.

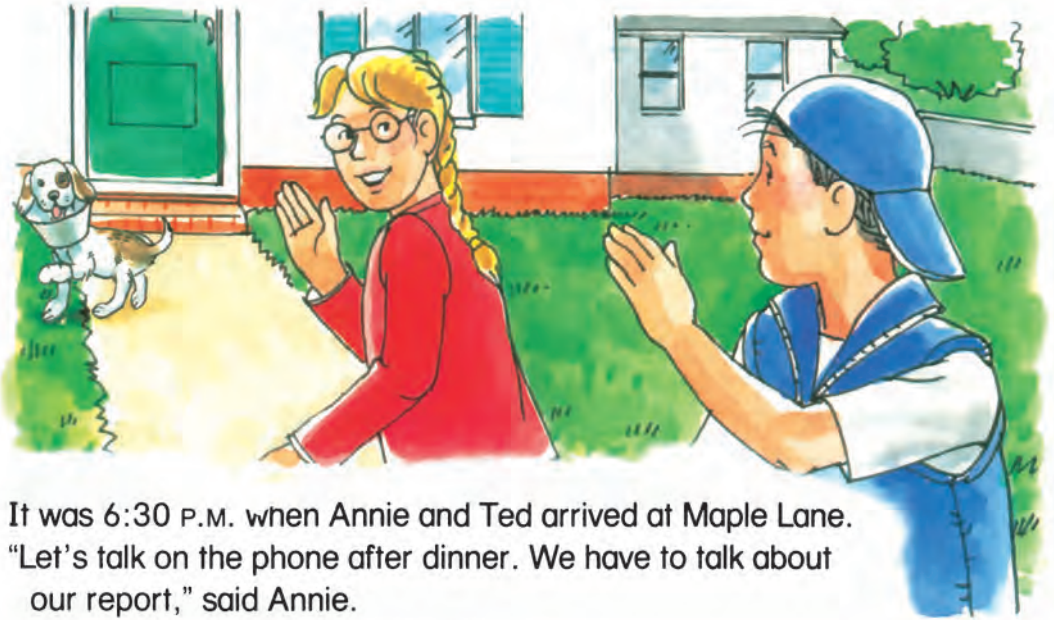
Annie and Ted left the clinic. Annie was quiet.

On Saturday morning, there were a lot of people at the Clean Sunnyville Walk. There were free donuts, too.

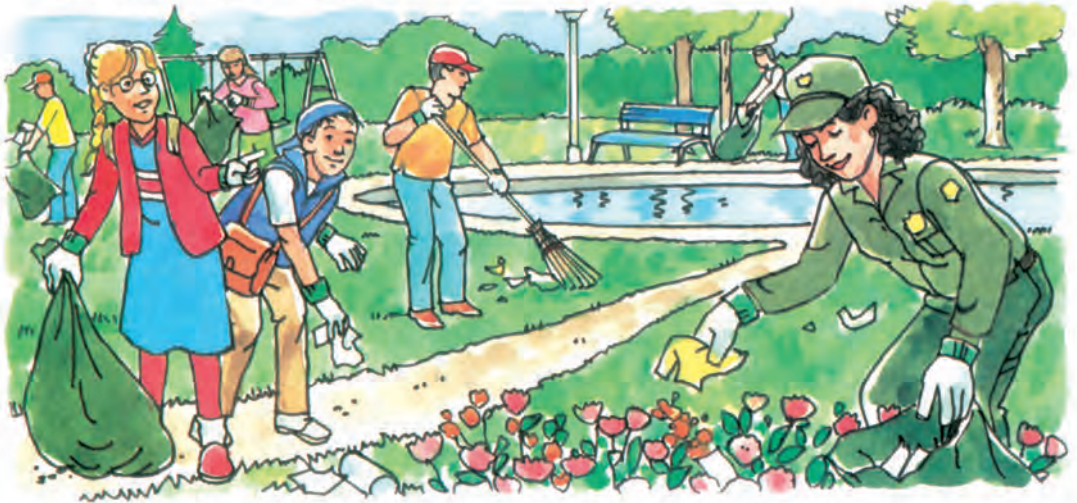
"Ted, you ate three donuts! Aren't you full?" asked Annie.

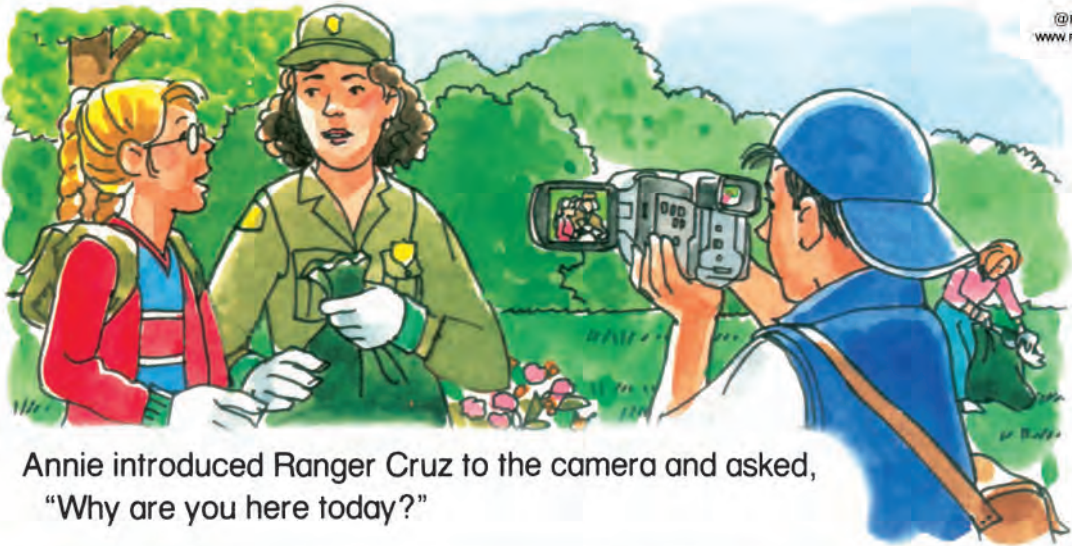

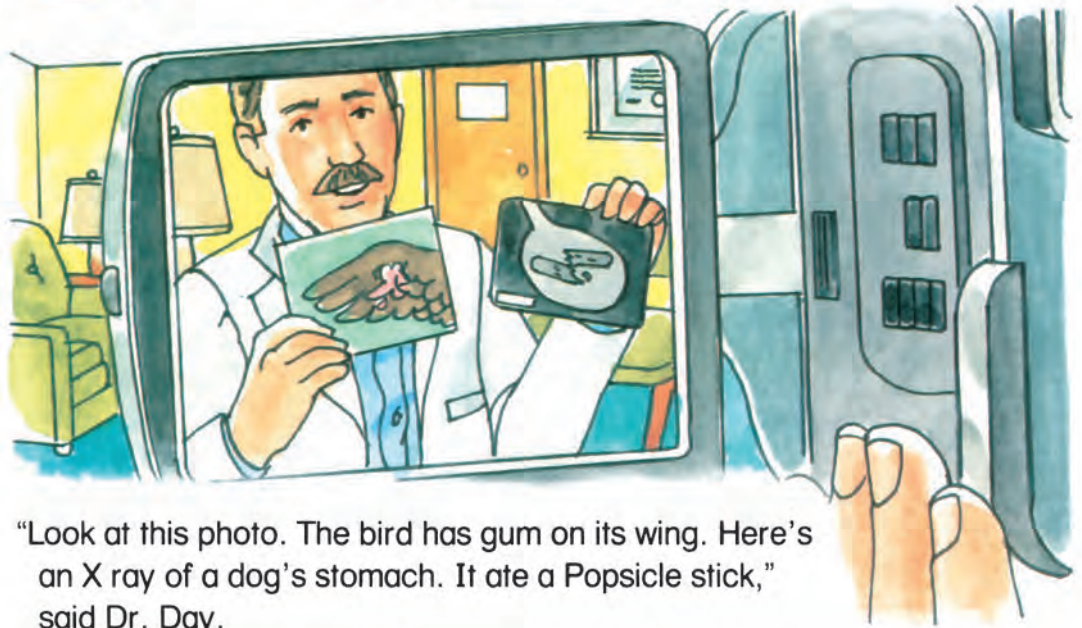
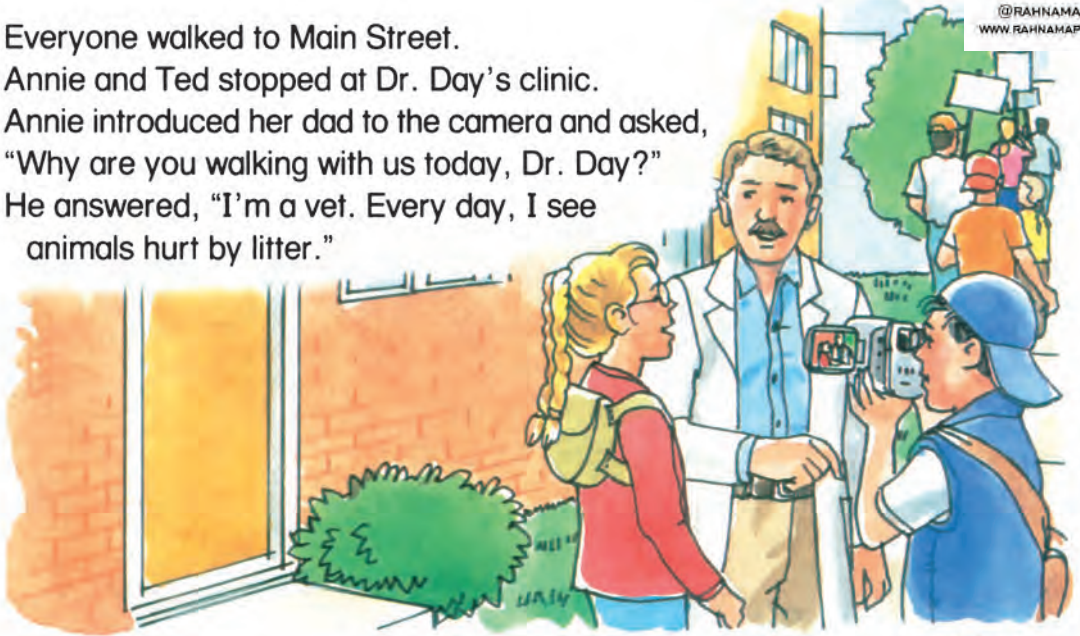
