Jane and the Acrobats



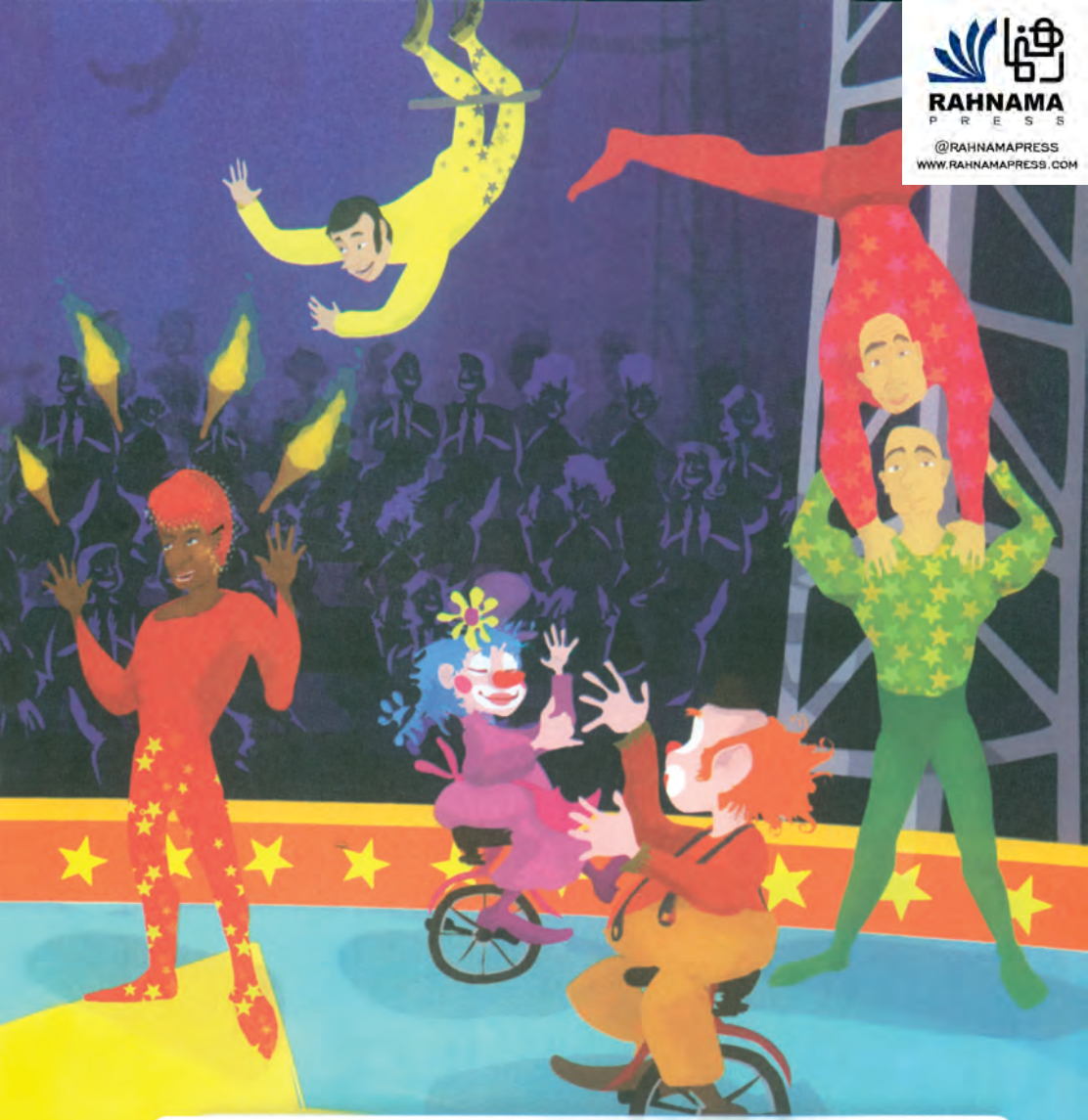
