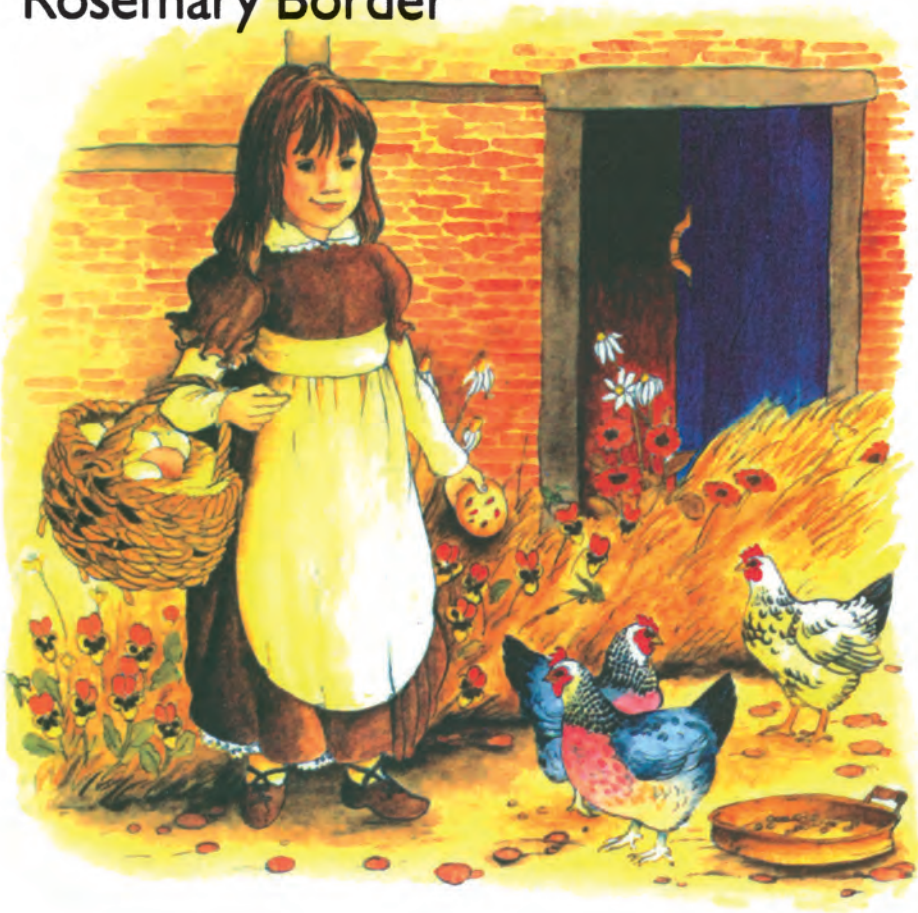

and a handkerchief.



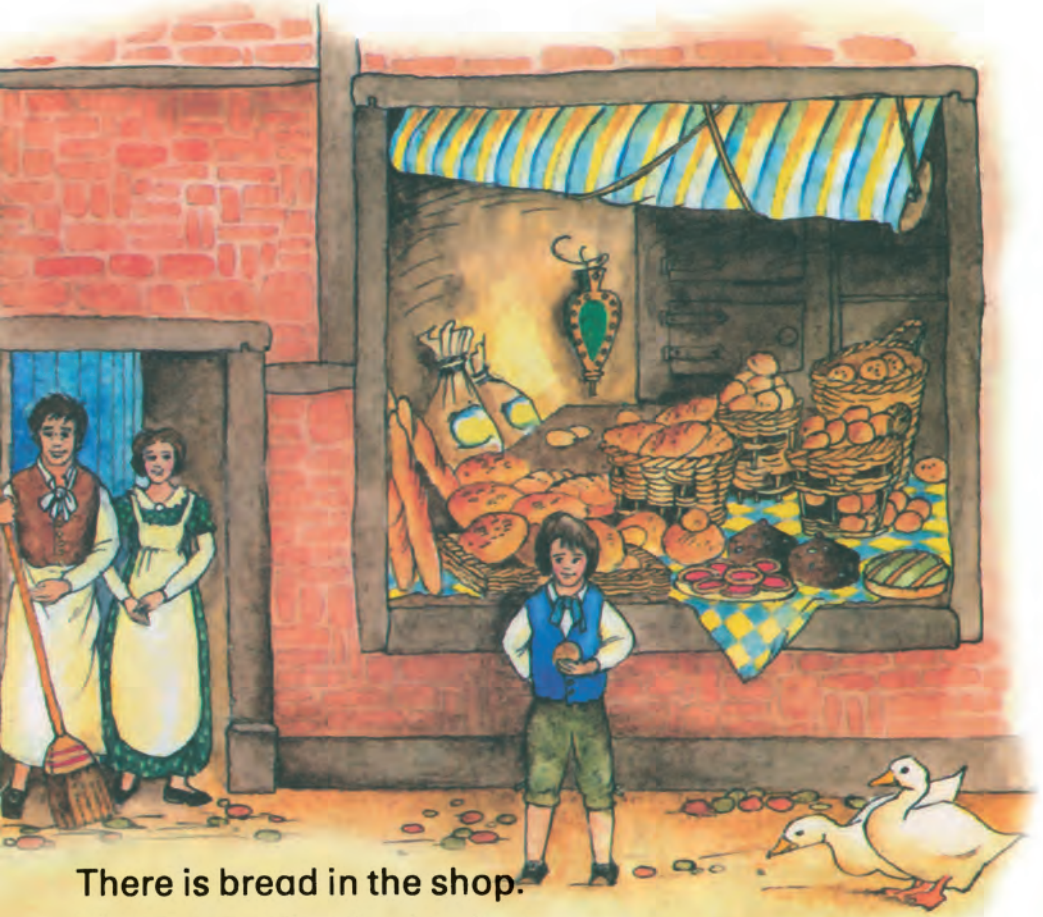
This is the little girl.

There are two shops and there is one school.



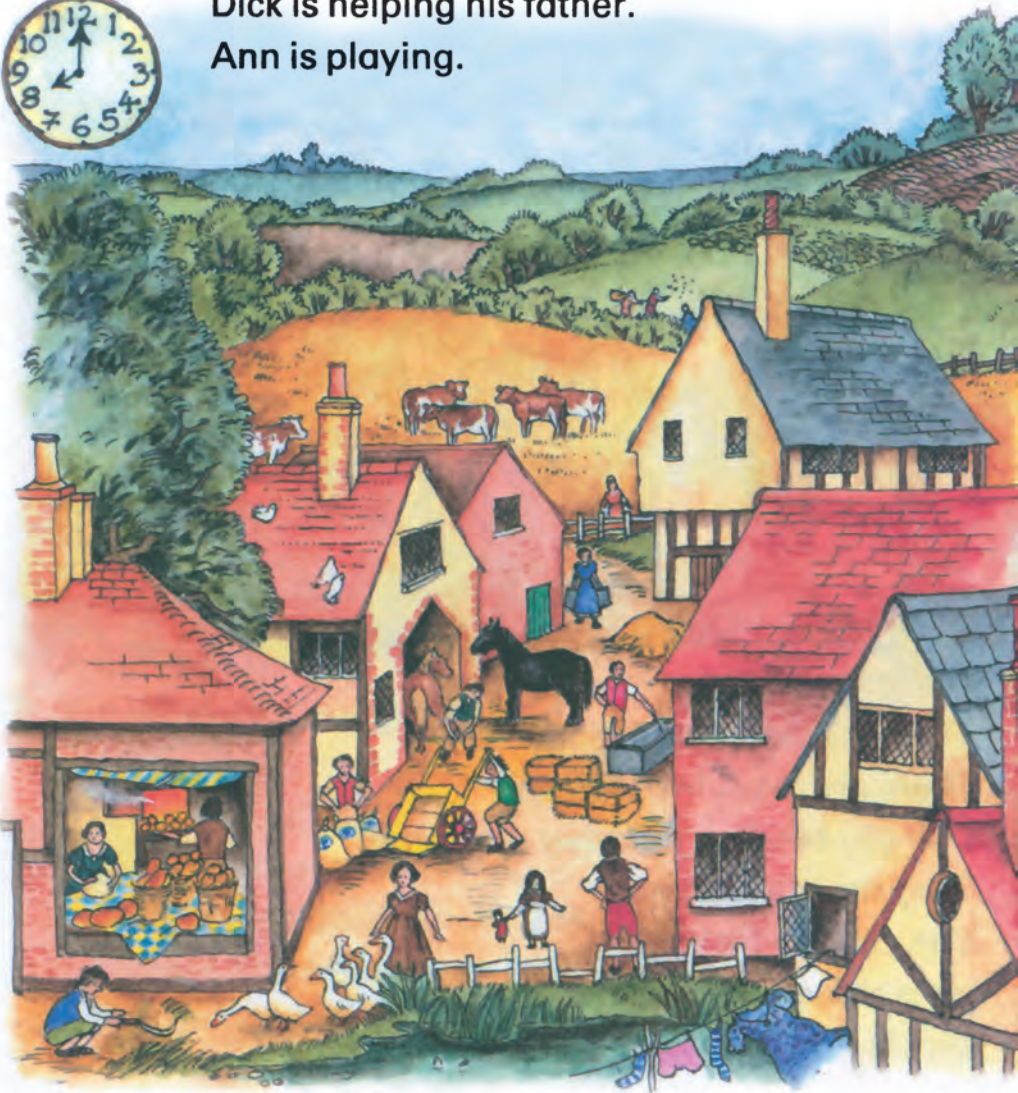
Can you see Ann's house?
