- If you had more free time, how would you spend it? [Why?]

■ Task Four: Focus on language

1. Expressions of liking and disliking

Both Inmi and Leonardo say that they prefer taking photos of people. Look at the following expressions of liking and disliking and decide whether they are followed by the infinitive (with or without 'to') or the gerund ('-ing').

2. Adverbs of frequency

The first question on photos asks **how often** the candidate takes photos, and the first question on free time asks how much free time the candidate **normally** has. In the question on taking photos Leonardo says 'I **usually** take photos when I go on a trip.'

Put the following adverbs of frequency in order starting with the most frequent and ending with the least frequent. Note that some of them have the same meaning.
